THE THREE GOVERNING BODIES OF CAEP

Board

- Manage the affairs of CAEP
- Adopt Standards
- Approve policy
- Monitor the implementation of Standards and policy

Accreditation Council

- Make decisions regarding accreditation
- Certify whether review panels followed policies and procedures
- Handle complaints involving EPPs

Appeals Council

- Hear and decide appeals to Accreditation Council decisions

THE ROLE OF THE CAEP BOARD

- Elect the directors and officers of the Board, appoint the chairs and other members of its committees, and appoint the Chair of its Accreditation Council
- Adopt revised standards
- Review and approve the CAEP strategic plan
- Review the activities and performance of CAEP, its Accreditation Council, and any other accrediting bodies maintained by CAEP, *but not individual accreditation decisions*
- Review and approve the annual budget of CAEP, amendments to such budget, long term financial plans, and provide for and review an annual independent audit of CAEP's financial records
- Ratify amendments to the Bylaws, CAEP Policy, and Accreditation Policy
