- Possess leadership potential and strong commitment to research.

- Experience in college level teaching.
- Demonstrated potential or a record of significant contributions to educational research.
- Working with English language learners in a K-12 setting with experience in American schools preferred
- Strong commitment to teaching excellence /student success.

- Excellent communication/interpersonal skills.
- Commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion.
